Tight grain, medium toast barrels from a variety of coopers

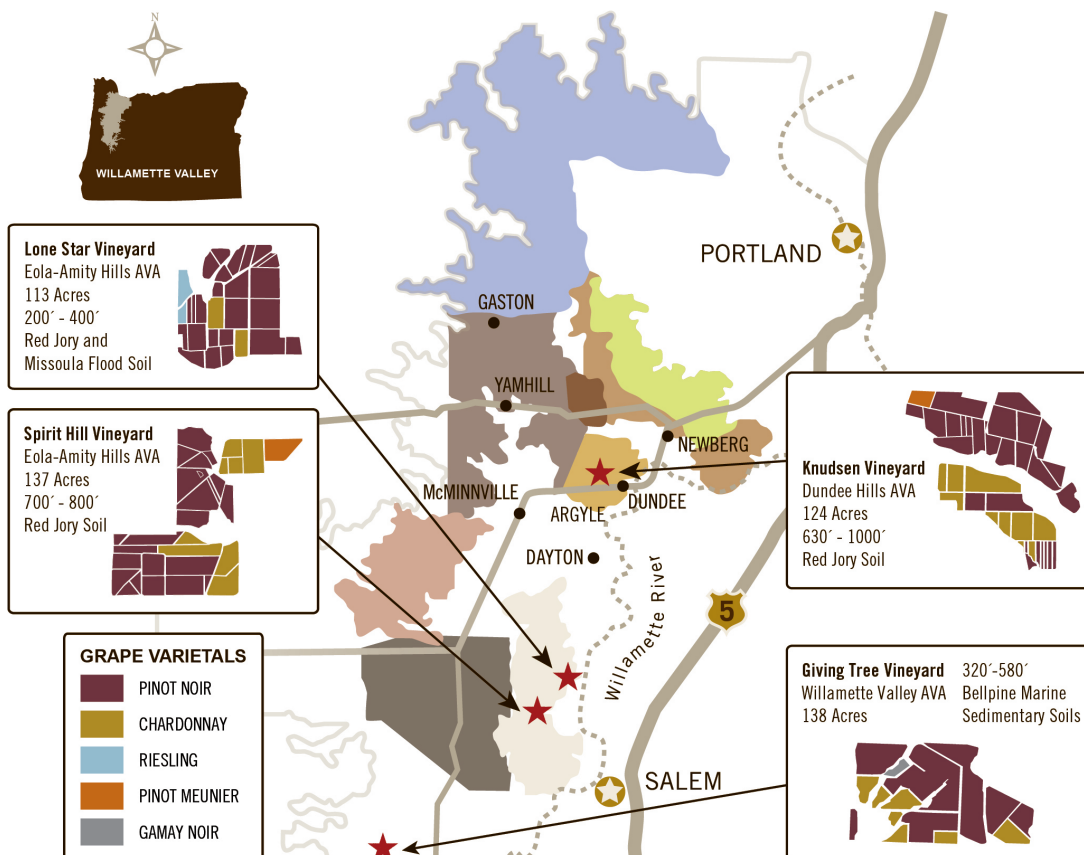

- **VINEYARD:** Argyle farms four estate vineyards making up nearly 500 acres in the Willamette Valley, with two vineyards in the Eola-Amity Hills AVA and one vineyard in the Dundee Hills AVA.
- **VITICULTURE:** Regenerative farming encourages the symbiotic relationship between the earth and the vine in tandem with the development of habitats for native flora and fauna. Our result from sustainable and responsible practices includes healthier soils, energetic vineyards and fruit.
